- II. In case of Self-financed, Non Government unaided Institutions, only the approved Heads of the institutions are allowed to receive.
  - They are requested to carry with them the latest approved list of faculty members where the name of the Head of the Institution features. In all cases of disposal or query, the list shall have to be submitted at the time of receiving the said Certificates.

The Heads of such institutions must carry their photo Identity Cards (Voter/Aadhar Card), issued by the competent authority to avoid impersonation.
